



A Draught of an Island in the River Susquehanna and Manor Township  
Lancaster County called Taylor's Island opposite York shore about three  
quarters of a mile fifteen perches from said shore, and about sixty perches  
from the Maple Island, about eighteen or twenty perches from the  
Island called Woods Island, lying on the course of the York shore  
opposite to Wisslers Island, which said Island Containing six perches  
strict measure, Surveyed in pursuance of a warrant dated the 7th  
day of November Anno Dom 1821, Granted to George Atwright &  
Martin Fink.
