



Draught of three hundred and thirty eight acres and thirty six perches of land with six per cent for Roads situate in Armagh township in Mifflin County. Surveyed 29th September 1812 in pursuance of a warrant to Philip Berger dated 29th August 1812. Improvement on the above represented land at time of Survey was a large Cabin and a family living in it, with a small clearing of land on which grain appeared to have been raised
