



Draught of four hundred and ten acres and one hundred and twenty two
poles of land with six per cent. estimate in Ternanagh Town-
ship in Mefflin County which appears to have been surveyed 16th.
May 1794, in consequence of a warrant to Nicholas Miller dated 21
January 1794 said to contain 401 $\frac{1}{2}$ acres Resurveyed 14 June 1809,
and found to contain as above mentioned.

Note. The small triangle shown by a dotted line on the above draught was included by the original survey and was part of a survey made 31st Jan^y 1785, on warrant to John Watson dated 13th December 1785, which is now cast out.
