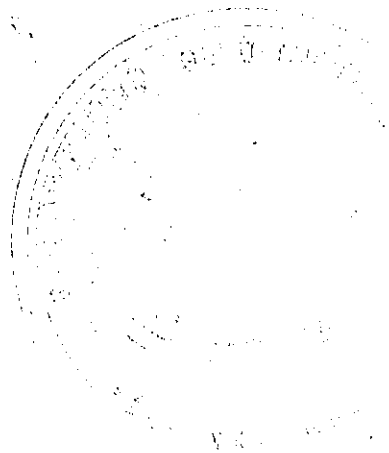


A Draught of a Tract of Land Called \_\_\_\_\_ situate (or) Neighcaanga or Reed
