Originally surveyed the 27<sup>th</sup> Day of August 1800 and Resurveyed the 8<sup>th</sup> Day of October 1804 in pursuance of a warrant Dated the 28<sup>th</sup> Day of December 1793 and Resurveyed and Corrected the 20<sup>th</sup> Day of November 1830 By Order of the Board of Property dated 18<sup>th</sup> October 1830.
