



A Draught of Two Tracts of Land Contiguous & adjoining situate in Paradise Township in the County of York Surveyed, alias Resurveyed for Conrad Doll. The Tract marked with the Letter A in right of Frederick Shulla by the Towne of Frederick Jolley by Warrant to him dated the 4th day of April 1754 Containing Eighty Nine Acres by one Hundred and Thirty Eight perches and allowance of six Per Cent.

The Tract marked with the Letter B in right of John Brady by Warrant to him dated the 18th day of July 1743 Containing Fifty nine acres and Fifty perches & the usual allowance of six Acres Per Cent for Roads &c.
