



Situate in York Township (formerly Hellam) in the County of York, Containing as above set forth 99^{ac} & 108^{ac} & alle and allowance. Being part of a larger tract originally surveyed on the 10th day of October 1752 by George Stevenson late D.S. in pursuance of Warrant dated the 18th day of December 1751, to Nathias Bargett. Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger tract on the 26th day of the first month 1775 by William Matthews late D.S. and now, after having been carefully examined, corrected and calculated, at the request of the present owner Jacob Zeller, it is returned for Confirmation the 5th day of August Anno Domini 1809.
