



Situate in Koenheim Township in the County of York, Containing as above set forth 180 & 141 Perches and allowance &c. Being part of a larger tract of 150 & 76 perches & allowance of Land, which was originally surveyed by Archibald McLean dated on the 26<sup>th</sup> day of May, 1766, in pursuance of a warrant for 100<sup>0</sup> Granted to Philip Bettsfield bearing date the 30<sup>th</sup> day of April, AD<sup>o</sup> 1765. Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger tract of Land at the request of the present owner George Stoyer the 10<sup>th</sup> day of May, AD<sup>o</sup> 1810, who desired the same to be returned for Confirmation —
