



Situate in Warriorsmark Township, Huntingdon County, Containing One hundred & fifty one acres and thirty eight perches and the usual allowance to it being a part of a larger tract of land which was surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted to John Baynton and Samuel Wharton dated the 28th day of July 1766 for 557 acres & allowance surveyed and divided from the residue of said tract January the 18th 1853 by the request of George Treachooft
