



A Draught of a Tract of Lands Situate in Upper Millford Township in the County of Northampton (formerly Bucks) in the State of Pennsylvania. Containing Twenty Acres and 66 Perches of Land together with the usual allowance for Roads which was formerly Surveyed to Thomas Kern. By Warrant dated the 10<sup>th</sup> April Anno 1749 - who on the 1<sup>st</sup> May 1766 Sold the Same (together with his other Lands) to Ludwig Effert who again on the 25<sup>th</sup> April 1775. Sold the same to John Stantz: - Now resurveyed for the said John Stantz on the 26. January Anno 1785... By Special Order of George Palmer Deputy Surveyor for the said County. Under the Orders of the Surveyor General. directed to said Palmer
