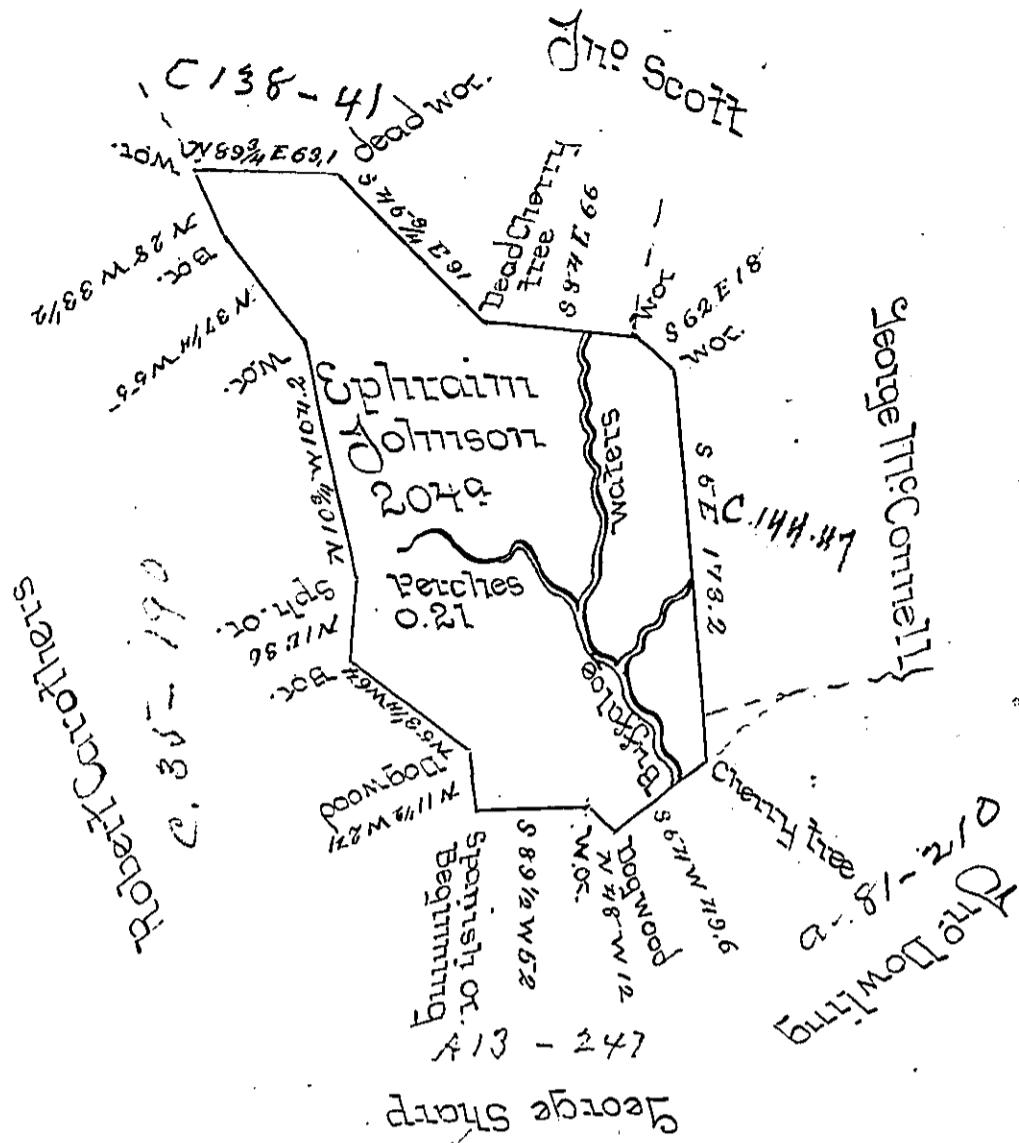


Hens of Thomas Saw
