



Situate in Newbury Township York County Containing as above set forth 574^{as} & 27 Perches and allowance Being part of a larger Tract of 172^{as} & 71 Perches and allowance, which was Originally surveyed by John Forsyth late D.S. --- on the 18th day of January 1794. in pursuance of a Warrant for 260^{as} granted to Jacob Dowdle dated the 1st day of ~~January~~ ^{February} 1794. Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger Tract of land the 13th day of November AD^o 1812. at the request of Jacob Dowdle the present owner, who desired the same to be Returned for Confirmation. -
