Being part of a larger Tract of 53² and allowance &c. which was Originally Surveyed on the 25th day of November 1787 by John Forsyth late U.S. for Jonathan McCreevy in Pursuance of a Warrant granted to Jonas Chamberlain bearing date the 7th day of March A.D. 1749. Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger Tract by the said Forsyth on the 20th day of February 1797. And now at the request of the owner Peter Mathias the same has been calculated examined &c. and found Correct and his request Returned for Confirmation the 30th day of October 1813.
