



The line of the Manor is N 40° or S. 40° W. but is here called S 46 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. Therefore this Draught is not to be depended on.

Nicholas Scull has since examined the lines & finds the quantity 350a & allowance &c & the lines different from this Act. See his Draught & return'd Decr. 18th Augt. 1789. The Warr'd date 22 Feb. 1714-5.
