



Situated in Reading Township Adams County the largest part Surveyed about the year 1766 or 67 by Charles Lukens US by an order of Survey No 42 dated August 1st 1766 to George Ernest for 150^a resurveyed April 15th & 16th 1807 including a small Vacancy containing 4^a 11^{rs} & all lying between Christian Bushley's land and the Survey made by C. Lukens both the lines & corners well marked and from the appearance of the marks on the trees they were marked many years ago. The corners were also standing. Christian Bushley was present when I ran the lines and admitted that his land was surveyed by John Forsyth US and the Vacancy left out probably there is a return of his in the office in the name of George Stevenson.
