



Situated in Reading Township Adams County the largest part surveyed about the year 1766 or 67 by Charles Lukens DS by an order of Survey No 427 dated August 1st 1766 to George Ernest or 150<sup>a</sup> resurveyed April 15<sup>th</sup> & 16<sup>th</sup> 1807 including a small vacancy containing 40 117<sup>ps</sup> & all lying between Christian Busheys land and the survey made by C. Lukens both the lines of ground well marked and from the appearance of the marks on the trees they were marked many years ago the corners were also standing. Christian Bushey was present when I ran the lines and admitted that his land was surveyed by John Forsyth the DS. and the vacancy left out probably there is a return of his in the office in the name of George Stevenson.
