



The above is a draught of survey made September 19th 1756 on Certificate granted by the Commissioners to William Carson Dated December 21st 1779: Called Pigeons Flat: Containing 229 Acres & 2 perches & is situate in Washington County the Western Part of the County of Ohio. A True Copy David Redick D.S. We the Commissioners appointed for adjusting Claims to unpatented lands in the Counties of Monmouth, Logan, & Ohio do hereby certify that William Carson is entitled to four hundred Acres of land; in the County of Ohio; situate on the Waters of Buffalo to include his settlement made in the Year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and seventy four given under our hands at Redstone Old on the twenty first Day of December 1779 and in the fourth year of the Commonwealth West.
