



Situate in West Brunswick township Schuylkill County containing 225 as 79 perches and the usual allowance of six percent & - being part of 398 as 67 perches & allowance &c. surveyed on the 20th of May 1755 in pursuance of two Warrants dated the 4th day of March A.D. 1750. Granted to John Webb as appears by a Draft made by Henry Vanderslice late a Deputy Surveyor, and now remaining in my Office Resurveyed on the 30th of July 1837 for the Heirs of Jacob Faust Deceased
