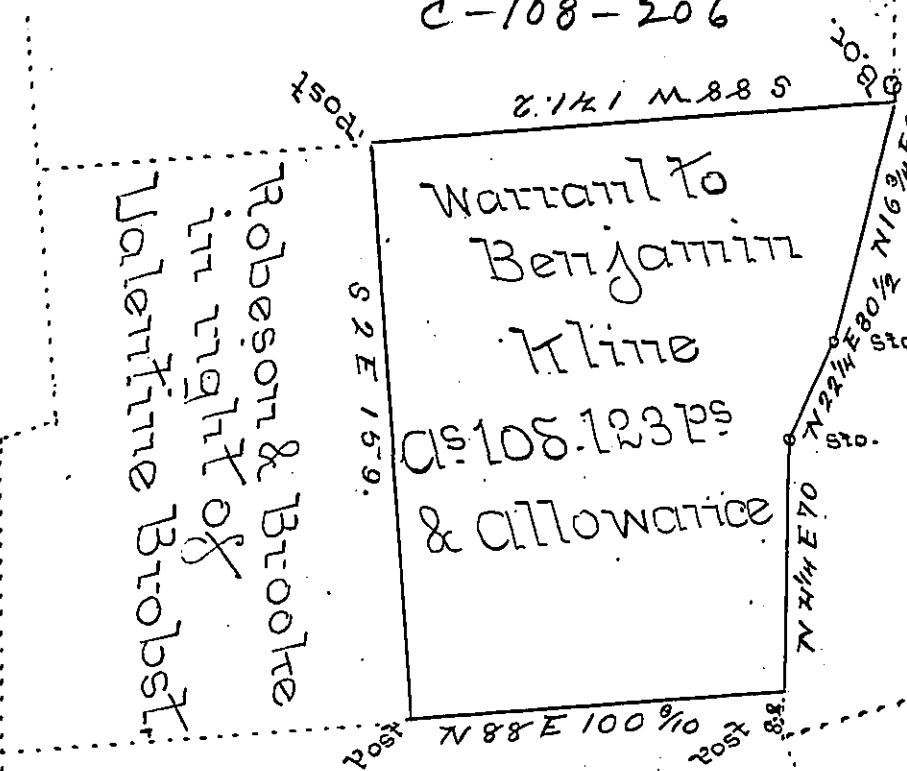

By virtue of a Warrant, dated the ninth day of February A.D. 1845, granted to Benjamin Kline, and in pursuance of the direction of the Board of Property Co of the 3^d of September 1851.) there was Resurveyed the above described tract of land, in Upper Tulpehocken township, Berks County, containing one hundred and eight acres one hundred & twenty three perches and allowance of 6 PC^t for roads &c now owned by Henry P. Robeson, and Clement Brooke - September 9th 1851.
