



Situate on Dunbars Run about five miles above Measons old furnace in Dunbar township, Fayette County & surveyed the day of _____ 1795 in pursuance of a Warrant in the name of said Dillon for 400 acres of land dated the 28th day of December 1793.

The foregoing is made out from the field notes & calculation of Morris Morris. I find it located as the Warrant directs and am informed by Alex^r McClean that sd Morris was duly authorized by him to make this and several other surveys near the same place in the summer of 1795 he thinks in the month of June of that year. There is yet no improvement on the land.
