



Situate in Dawn Township, now in the County of York on the South side of Muddy Creek, on the west side of Susquehanna River containing as above set forth 122^a & 74 Perches and Allowance &c. Being part of a larger Tract of 219^a and Allowance &c. which was originally surveyed by George Churchman late D.S. on the 29th day of October A.D. 1744 in Pursuance of a Warrant granted to Thomas Bowles bearing date the 19th day of June 1744. Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger Tract of Land the 22^d day of May A.D. 1810. at the request of the Present owner Robert Ramsey who desired the same to be returned for Confirmation.
