



This Draught describes a small Tract of Land Surveyed for Joshua Bradley in Pursuance of a Warrant bearing Date the 21st day of July 1775 - situate in Town Township near the South Branch (& above the Forks) of Muddy Creek in York County, Beginning at a Marked Red Oak Standing near the Head of a Branch running into the said South Branch, & running thence the several Courses & Distances above described being not far distant from the Widow McConnell's Improvement
