



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Hon^{ble} Proprietaries bearing Date the 24th Day of January Anno Dom 1737 I have Survey'd unto Samuel Bethel in the Township of Hopeobl. in the County of Lancaster on the west side Susquehanna River one hundred and seventy six acres with Allowance of six Percent & Beginning at a white Oak Thence North sixty Degrees Westerly one hundred and eighty Pches to a Hickory Thence north Thirty Degrees Easterly Two hundred Pches to a white Oak Thence South sixty Degrees Easterly one hundred and Twenty Pches to a Chestnut Oak Thence South Thirteen Degrees westerly Two hundred and Ten Pches to the place of Beginning Survey'd May ye 24th 1737 P
