Note It appears from notes on the back of the above described Warrant, and lines on the ground, that Frederick Evans Esq: the then proper deputy Surveyor of the District, had begun a survey in October 1793 but did not finish the same -

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this first day of November 1898.
