



By Virtue of a Warrant dated the 20th February 1793 Surveyed the 9th September 1793 to John Jacobs the above described Tract of Land situate in the great Pine Swamp three Miles & an half South East of where a marked Line of Trees crosses Behright near the Triangle Rock two or three Miles below the Mouth of Bear Creek to include a small Creek and Falls therein near where said Line of marked Trees crosses said Creek and on both sides of said Line of marked Trees in Northampton County Containing four hundred Acres and the Allowance of six per Cent &c.
