 and contains Fifty Three Acres and Forty Nine perches
 & the usual Allowance of Six Acres Percent for Roads &c -
 The part where the letter B is placed is an exact copy
 made by William Kersey late Deputy Surveyor said
 by him to contain one Hundred & Sixty Two Acres &
 Eighty Two perches as Returned in Right of Martin Ebert
 in Pursuance of a Warrant Dated the 17th July 1758.
