



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Honble the Proprietaries dated the 11th day of November 1746 I Surveyed on the 21th day of July 1748 to John Furley ^{and others the Heirs} in right of his Father Benjamin Furley in lieu of his Front Lot a certain lot of ground above described Situate in Philada^a between the 9 and 10 Streets containing in Breadth on High Street 132 Feet & in Depth 306 Feet Bounded on the South ward with High Street afore said ^{Westward} ~~Northward~~ with Tenth street Northward with Vacant ground & Eastward with a lot of ground laid out to John Simcock.
