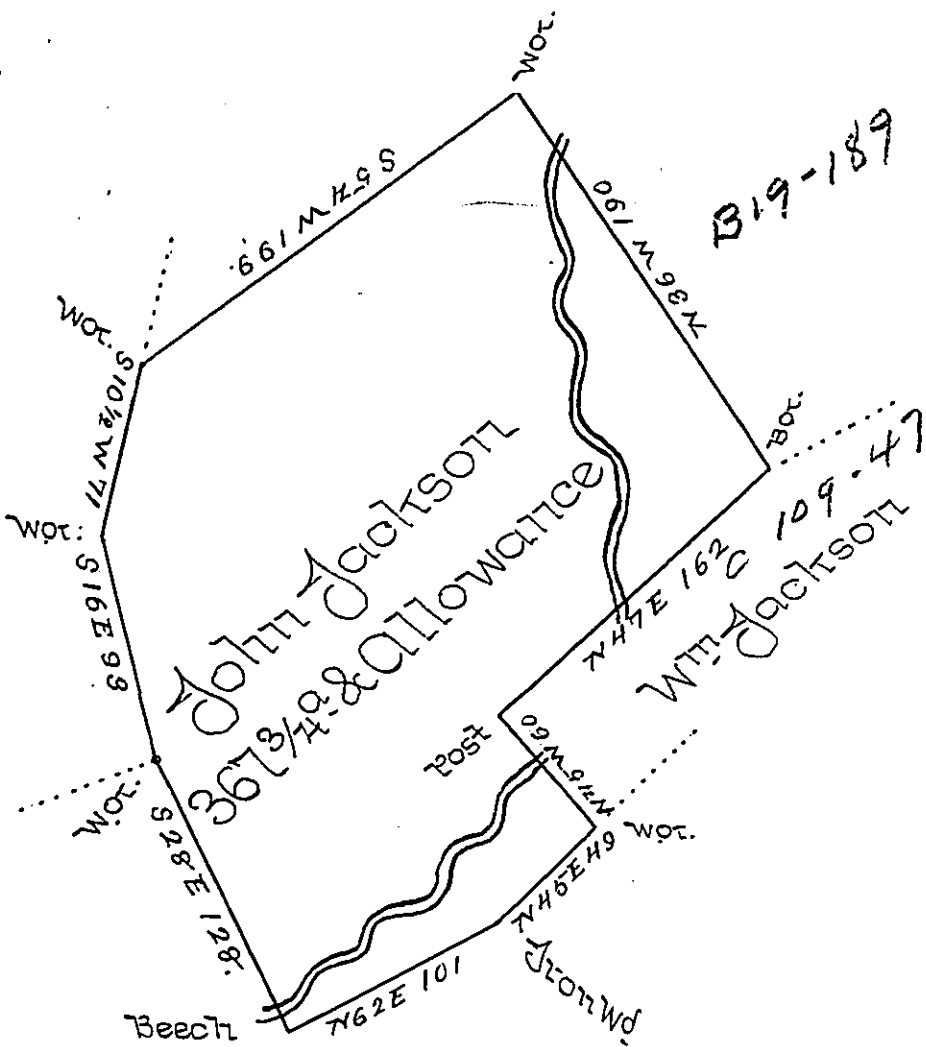

The above described tract of three hundred & sixty seven acres & three quarters of an acre & allowance of six pCent. situate on the North side of Kishaminates between Roaring Run & Catling Run a small distance above the forks of said Runs adjoining lands of William Jackson on the South East side & Michael Campbell on the West side, including an improvement in Westmoreland County. By warrant of the 28th day of March 1786
