



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries dated the fourteenth day of March 1733 Surveyed to Michael Fisher a tract of Land ^{of} situate near Maiden Creek in the County of Philadelphia Beginning at a post being a Corner of Isaac Maylins land thence by Vacant land North Seventy Degrees East One hundred and sixty perches to a post thence by Vacant land South twenty Degrees East One hundred and fifty Nine perches to a post thence by Vacant land South Seventy Degrees West One hundred and sixty perches to a post in the line of the above sd Maylins land thence by the same North twenty Degrees West One hundred and fifty nine perches to the place of beginning Cont. One hundred and fifty acres with the usual Allowance of Six Percent Surveyed August 29th 1734 by Nich^o Scull.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this first day of November 1898.
