



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietor Dated the 28 Day of November Anno Dom. 1737. The above Described Tract of Land was Surveyed unto William Helwig in the Township of Heidelberg on the South and the Township of Tulpehocken on the North Side of the Creek in the County of Lancaster Beginning at a Black Oak Thence South West by Vacant Land 240 perches to a Black Oak &c. Containing Two Hundred and Thirty one acres Beside ye Allowance of six PCent 21<sup>st</sup> 20<sup>th</sup> 1738.
