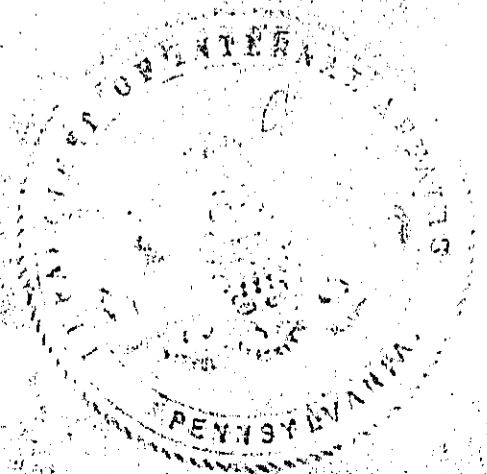


A Draught of a Tract of Land situate in Warwick Township in the County of Lancaster containing one hundred and forty Acres and Sixty five perches and the Allowance of six Acres Percent for Roads and Highways surveyed the 26th day of February 1753 by Thomas Cookson Esquire late Deputy Surveyor of Lancaster County for Christian Erb in pursuance of a Warrant bearing date at Philadelphia the 5th day of November 1752.

Protracted from Mr Cookson's Field Book & Calculated by Geo. Stevenson one of the Exec^{ts} of Thos Cookson Deceased. Note. The Bearer has a Draught of 100^{as} Land in the Name of Andreas Eliaman signed by Mr Cookson, which he thinks adjoins this Tract - I am doubtful this Draught includes that 100^{as} but not certain having never seen the Land &c.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this sixth day of December 1898.
