

Pennsylvania ss.

In pursuance of a Warrant dated the 29 Day of April 1745 I have resurveyed unto John Edwards a Tract of Land Situate in Litchland Township in the County of Chester Beginning at a Marked hickery at a corner of Cadwalder Jones's Land and from thence extending by the same North Twelve Degrees West one hundred and Ten perches to a small white oak marked Thence North Seventy five Degrees East one hundred and twenty perches to a small hickery marked in a line of Joseph Pike's Land Thence by the same one hundred and thirty two perches to a heap of Stones thence by John David's Land West by South one hundred and four acres Returned into the Secretarys Office the 1st of May 1745.
