



Situate in Shrewsbury Township York County containing  
within the black lines, as above set forth, fifty acres,  
one hundred and twenty perches, and allowance of six per cent  
for Roads &c being part of a larger tract of 65 acres & all  
allowance, which was originally Surveyed by William Hershey  
late U.S. on the 29<sup>th</sup> of the month of November 1793 in consequence of a War-  
rant granted to Andrew Smith for 75<sup>ac</sup>s dated 26<sup>th</sup> October A.D.  
1791. The above part resurveyed and divided off from the  
said larger tract the 5<sup>th</sup> day of October 1891 at the request  
of Christian Hershey the present owner of said tract who  
desires the same to be returned for confirmation.
