



Situate in Codorus Township in the County of York Containing 180 and 112 perches & allowance &c. part of 50 1/2 acs & allowance &c. Which was originally surveyed on the 29th of the 3^d month 1768. by William Matthews, late U.S. in pursuance of an Application. N^o 3792 entered the 2^d day of June, 1767. in the name of Casper Kerchner - including a part of a tract of land prior surveyed, in pursuance of a warrant granted to a certain Joseph McKinney bearing date the 26th day of March 1760, and intended in the name of Thomas O'Connor - Resurveyed and the error corrected, excluding the survey of a prior date, in the presence of the parties concerning, on the 10th day of August A.D. 1836, by Daniel Seese late U.S. and now on the 19th day of September A.D. 1864. Examined and found correct the above &c and at the request of the present owner George Henry, the same is now returned for Confirmation and having the same patented.
