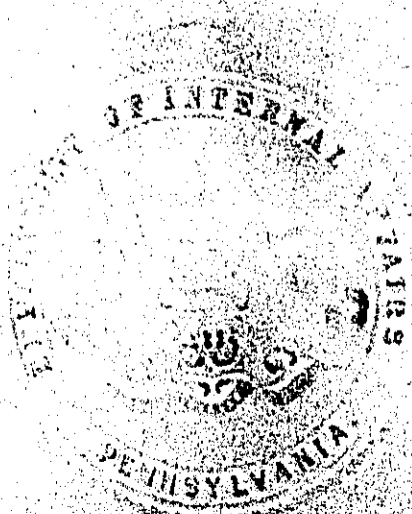


Surveyed January 27<sup>th</sup> 1837 in pursuance of a warrant dated the 12<sup>th</sup> day of January 1837 granted to James Scott, situate on the waters of the South fork of Ten Mile Creek, Centre Township in the County of Greene containing 12 acres and 123 perches and the allowance of 6 per Cent. Called "Retreat"
