



The foregoing is a copy of Joseph Pennock's part of the Samuel Lyon Sr. survey on Order No 3438 of 13<sup>th</sup> June 1769 the whole of this tract (439 3/4 c) being part of a preemption right 1000 acres on a Virginia certificate dated 8<sup>th</sup> March 1760 to Thomas in Right of Christopher Island so returned by me in the year 1829 or 30 in pursuance of a Contract with the Board of property this part was surveyed by me in 1833 and returned for Pennock who wishes a patent. The land is situated on the head waters of Gists run in Union Township Fayette County it is nearly all cleared and well improved and has a part of it been cultivated 50 or 60 years or more. I believe the returns made on the Virginia right were not accepted and I was directed to make other returns on the Lyon Survey upon location or location this being the oldest right. I do certify that the above is a true copy of the above survey duly entered by me on the Books in my Office from the survey made by T. Lewis Esq. former Dep Surveyor James Snyder Dep. Co. Jacob Sallads Esq. Surveyor General. Mr Pennock requests the two enclosed Draughts to be included in one patent.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this third day of January 1899.
