



A Draught of a Tract of Land called Hunters Fancy situate in the Manor of Sumbury at the Upper End of the Shawney Flats adjoining Lands surveyed for Aaron Dupui late in the County of Northumberland but now in the County of Luzerne containing One hundred and Thirty two Acres Fifty Seven Perches besides the usual Allowance of six per Centum for Roads surveyed by William Gray Esq. late Deputy Surveyor for Col: Samuel Hunter in Right of Thomas Osburn the 24th Day of April 1763 in Pursuance of an Order from the Board of Property bearing Date the 4th Day of February 1771 and certified this 31st Day of March 1802 by me
