In Pursuance of a Warrant from the Proprietaries dated the 27th of June 1734, Surveyed unto Samuel Evans on the 7th of November 1735 a Tract of Land situate in Leacock Township in the County of Lancaster. -

Beginning at a Hickery at a corner of Simon King's Land thence West by the same 15 Pches to a Hickery thence North by West by Thomas David's Land 200 Pches to a post thence East by Philip Shieffer's Land 190 Pches to a post thence South by John Muselemans Land 137 Pches to a Black Oak, thence East by South, by Thomas Small's Land 54 Pches to a Hickery thence S.S. West by the same land 125 Pches to a Hickery thence West by the Land of John Milin & Roody Furr 90 Pches to a Post thence North by the Land of the sd Simon King Eighty Pches to a White Oak, thence North by West by the same Land 60 pches to the Place of Beginning Containing Two Hundred and Ninety Seven Acres & the Allowance of Six Percent
