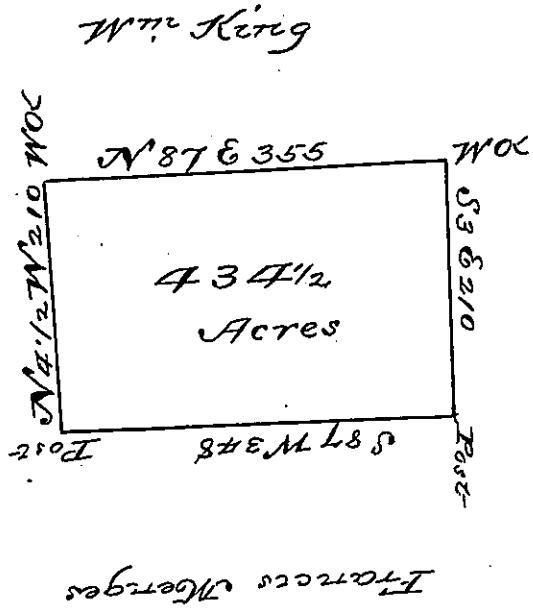


Surveys made by Cap^t J. Henderson
