



A Draught of a Tract of Land Situate for the greater part thereof in Upper Merford Township in the County of Northampton (formerly Bucks) and a small part thereof in Hereford Township in the County of Berks (formerly Philadelphia) Containing Thirty-seven acres and 27 perches of Land together with the usual allowance at six per cent for Roads &c. Being the full half part of a Tract of 74 1/2 perches, that was formerly surveyed unto Matthias Hain bought by virtue of a warrant of the 8th day of May Anno 1750. Whose right to the same was vacated by another Warrant dated the sixth day of April Anno 1767 and the above part thereof granted unto Catherine Eck. By virtue whereof the above was resurveyed on the 16th April Anno 1767. By order of the Surveyor General,
