



In pursuance of an Order from the Commissioners of Property dated the 16<sup>th</sup> day of June 1773 a survey was made on the 3<sup>d</sup> day of July following for Joshua Elder of a certain ~~part of~~ Lot of ground in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland marked in the General Plan of said Town Number One hundred and seventy eight, Containing in Breadth East and West sixty feet, and in length North and South Two hundred and thirty feet, Bounded Southward by Blackberry Street, Eastward by Lot Number One hundred and seventy seven, Northward by Barberrry Alley and Westward by Lot Number One hundred and seventy nine. Returned into the Secretarys Office the 27<sup>th</sup> day of August 1773. for Joshua Elder by warrant dated the 25<sup>th</sup> Instant.
