1737. The above named Tract of Land was surveyed unto David Evans in Cocalico
Township in the County of Lancaster. Beginning at a small Hickory Thence South
West by other Land of y^co David Evans 218 perches to a Hickory, Thence South
East 40 perches to a Hickory, Thence North East by the settlement of John
Moon 218 perches to a post. Thence North West by back Land 40 perches to
the place of beginning. Containing fifty one acres beside an allowance of six
ft. Cert for Roads.
