Beginning at a small Hickery Thence South West by other Land of y^e s^r David Evans 218 perches to a Hickery, Thence South East 40 perches to a Hickery, Thence North East by the settlement of John Moon 218 perches to a post. Thence North West by Vack Land 40 perches to y^e place of beginning. Containing fifty one acres beside y^e allowance of six p. Cent for Roads
