



In pursuance of a warrant of 400 acres, granted to Saml Duffield dated the 30th day of May 1792 - was surveyed on the 15th day of February 1830 for Hugh Rhodes the above described tract of land containing 336 acres & 14 perches, and allowance of six per cent for Roads &c. and that the said Hugh Rhodes was residing on the same and there appeared upwards of 15 acres cleared fenced and in a state of cultivation situate in Dadebury Township Crawford County Pennsylvania
