



The above describes a Tract of Land situate in Hamilton Township in the County of Franklin (formerly Cumberland), containing one hundred eighty nine acres seven perches & the allowance of six per cent for Roads &c. being part of a tract of 284 acres, which by a Copy of the Draft (signed by John Lukens &c.) appears to have been surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Joseph Kingery bearing date the 8th day of April 1763. The above part was resurveyed & laid off by Daniel Henderson Esq. (formerly Deputy Surveyor) on the 9th of October 1800, as appears by an Official Draught thereof remaining in my Office, which Draft I have examined and find correct.
