



By virtue of a Warrant dated at Philadelphia on the 24th day of January Anno 1754 granted to John Shadd. The above described two Tracts of Land, Situated in Whitehall Township, in the County of Northampton and Province of Pennsylvania. The one containing twenty seven acres and 20 perches with the Allowance. The second containing fourteen acres and 24 perches with the allowance, Containing together Forty two acres and 44 perches of land, together with the usual allowance at six per cent for Roads, was Surveyed for the said John Shadd who afterwards sold his Right to the same to Samuel Sager on the first day of June Anno 1754.
