Surveyed unto Casper Houckhouse in a Tract of Land part in the County of Philadelphia
& part in the County of Bucks situate in Newcowsesoppen Beginning at a
post a corner of John Springmans and thence by land of George Shoemaker North
fifty eight degrees East one hundred thirty nine perches to a post. thence
by land of Ureck Raser North two hundred perches to a post. thence by Ua-
cant Land South West two hundred seventy six to a post thence by Vact.
land & land of s. d. Springman South East one hundred & ten perches to the place
of Beginning. Containing One hundred fifty eight acres with the usual ar-
reance of six per cent. Surveyed April 22nd 1734
