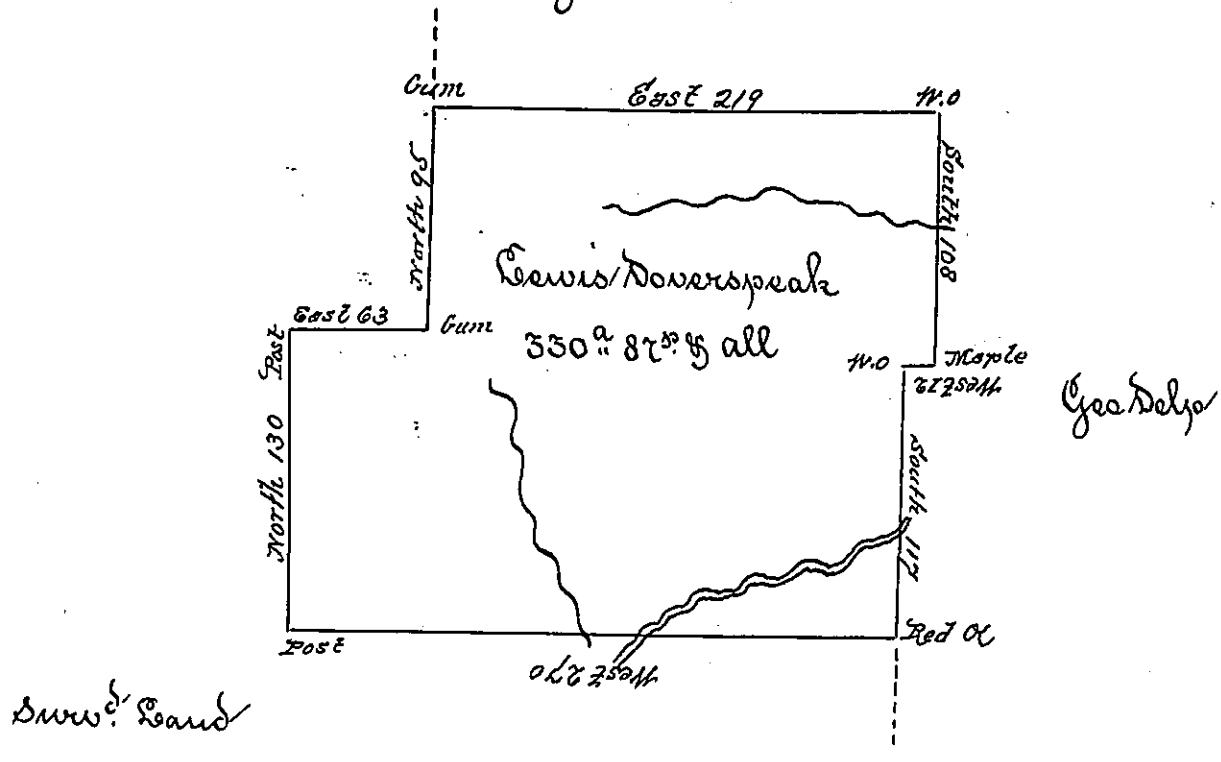


John Brown
