 lowance. Being part of a larger tract of land originally surveyed by William Matthews late  
 D.S. on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of August 1770, in pursuance of an Application No: 5584, dated the 28<sup>th</sup> day of  
 August 1769 granted to Jacob Stronman for 150<sup>a</sup>. Resurveyed and divided off from the said  
 larger tract on the 20<sup>th</sup> of April 1797, by John Forsyth late D.S. And now after having been care-  
 fully examined corrected and calculated, it is at the request of the present owner Peter Diehl,  
 returned for Confirmation the 2<sup>th</sup> day of August A.D. 1809.
