



By Virtue of a warrant from the Hon<sup>ble</sup> Proprietaries bearing Date the third Day of Decem<sup>r</sup> An-  
 no. D: 1740 I have survey'd and laid out unto Nathan Hussey in the Township of ~~Stewart~~<sup>Stewart</sup>  
~~formerly~~<sup>now York Co</sup> in the County of Lancaster, on west side Susquehanna river one hundred seventy eight Acres  
 with allowance of six percent in two pieces, one piece being an Island in the said river the other  
 piece begins at a Dock by the S. river thence South sixty eight Degrees Westerly fifty one perch-  
 es to a Spanish Oak thence north thirty Degrees westerly forty four perches to a Black Oak  
 thence north ten Degrees Westerly one hundred and ninety one perches to a Gum Tree thence  
 North thirty three perches to a Black Oak thence north five Degrees Easterly fifty five perches  
 to a poplar thence East eighty two perches to a Locust by the said river then down the same  
 near about three hundred and fifty perches to the place of Beginning  
 Survey'd May 20<sup>th</sup> 1741 P<sup>me</sup> Zach Dutchess D<sup>o</sup>
